

May 23rd Blog Entry Edited

As you read through this report some of it is missing for security reasons. What is important is that we are first grateful to the Lord for sparing our lives and we are grateful to Roger and Janet for being in Zimbabwe at this time. Had they not been here I would have been cut to death by these men and we can only imagine what would have happened to Helen and Misty.

**At about 19:30 (7:30 pm) three men dressed in face masks covering their entire face entered the house through the flat attached to the house. This flat is the residence of Misty Bodkins; they tied her up and forced her not to say anything.

These thieves were carrying machetes and held one of the machetes to her neck to keep her quiet. They wanted to know how many were in the house in the living room where myself, Hunter Payne and Roger Meek were sitting watching TV.

They proceeded through the house and forced the other women who were Helen Begarly and Janet Meek who were in the Kitchen to also be quite using the threats of the machete to do them physical harm asking the same question, how many are in the house? One of the men the shortest of the three stayed in the kitchen holding all three ladies against their will. Two of the men proceeded to the living room.

I looked up from the seat I was sitting in and saw a tall slim man and another shorter slim man standing in the living room with machetes. As soon as we saw them we confronted them and over powered them. Two of the men lost their hoods that covered their faces in the struggle and revealed their nationality/race which was light skinned African or Coloured. Two of the men ran out of the house through the same entrance they had entered the house.

One of the thieves suffered physical harm to his face and head and left lots of blood on the floor. Another one I managed to take his machete from him and two of us cornered him in the house. He lost his hood that covered his face and revealing that he was of the Colored race or a light skinned African.

We could have killed him in defense but the Lord revealed that we should not do that so I tried to chase him out of the house. He ran down the stairs in the house and down the hall and to the second room on the left and managed to break the security bars and broke the glass as he jumped out the window. He was bleeding

very badly before he went out the window and ran for his escape. After that the SAS and Police were informed of the incident and came to respond.

As a result of this attack I suffered a serious 30cm cut to my head and also cuts to my hands and legs from where the accused had cut me with the machete.

So far we have only noted that the accused managed to steal fifty dollars (USD) which was in the possession of Miss Misty Bodkins.
